SB439 mandates that the two recommending physicians for minors seeking medical marijuana cannot practice at the same physical location, and at least one of these physicians must confirm that the minor applicant has been under their care or referred by a physician who has provided care for the minor for a minimum of one year, or five years if the minor has only received telemedicine consultations.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 439 states that the 2 recommending physicians as it relates to medical marijuana for minors may not be located at the same physical address. At least 1 of the physicians must also state that the minor applicant has been under the care of the physician or referred to by a physician who has cared for the minor for not less than 1 year, or not less than 5 years if the minor patient has only been seen by the physician through telemedicine. No fiscal impact is anticipated.
