**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 444 directs health benefit plans and the Oklahoma Medicaid program to provide reimbursement for certain benefits. The measure also ensure that denials of reimbursement are in compliance with the federal legislation. Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services indicate that this measure does not change the status quo and should not constitute a fiscal impact for the agency, and therefore, should not create an impact to the state budget. The committee substitute does not change the impact of the bill.
