**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 444 requires the Insurance Commissioner to keep current the list of billing codes included in the definition of Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model.

The measure directs all health benefit plans and the Oklahoma Medicaid Program to provide reimbursement for such benefits that are delivered through behavioral health integration and psychiatric collaborative care models.

The measure also requires that denials of reimbursement must be in compliance with the federal Paul Wellstone and Pete Domenici Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008 and the utilization review requirements.
