**Research Analysis**

Floor amendment 1 to the floor substitute to SB473 establishes a seventy-five year old age limit for serving as a member of the state Legislature, statewide elected official or official appointed to serve in the executive branch. An official that turns seventy-five during their term of office or appointment would lose their position within 30 days of turning seventy-five.
