**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to SB 516 makes multiple changes to the measure.

The amendment:

Removes the requirement for a charter school board to meet monthly and replaces it with a requirement to meet no fewer than 10 months per year;

Restores language prohibiting a charter school from offering curriculum similar to that offered by the School for the Blind and the School for the Deaf;

Requires all charter school board members to be residents of Oklahoma;

Requires, instead of allows, a charter sponsor to create a separate performance framework for a school that has been designated as an alternative education program;

Requires virtual charter schools to include data about mobility of the student population in their performance framework; and

Removes the requirement for any school contracting with an EMO to use the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System to report the total compensation package of the superintendent.
