Research Analysis

SB 67 subjects all state agencies that utilize motor vehicles from the statewide fleet to certain reporting requirements. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, Department of Transportation, Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, Commissioners of the Land Office, and the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education are exempt from the oversight and advice of the Fleet Management Division, but are still required to participate in all reporting duties. The measure also requires the Fleet Management Division to submit their financial and inventory report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and to the Speaker of the House of Representatives in addition to the Governor.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 67 requires all state agencies, including those normally exempt from the reporting requirements of the Fleet Management Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), to be subject to the reporting requirements of the Fleet Management Division. This measure also requires the end-of-year financial statement and fleet inventory for the Fleet Management Division to be sent to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives in addition to the Governor. Per OMES, this measure has no fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
