**Research Analysis**

SB 775 allows a board of county commissioners to decide the length of service needed for full-time county employees to qualify for the continuing education program. Participants are allowed to enroll in courses from any in-state or out-of-state institution as long as courses are relevant to the employee's duties as approved by the county commissioners.
