Bill Analysis

SB 1056 modifies current law relating to obscene material. The measure defines contemporary community standards for minors as obscene material with regards to a minor if certain conditions are met. Such conditions include if news outlets in an area the minor is located refuse to distribute certain material due to the belief the material is too obscene and if 2% or more of parents with minor children in the area where minors are potentially being given the material in question respond in a poll or other inquiry whether they would want to be informed and provide consent if the material in question were given to their child and 10% of the parents asked respond that they would want to be informed and provide consent for their child to receive the material in question.
