Bill Analysis

SB 1072 provides that any person responsible for the health and welfare of a child who participates in the act of child grooming shall be guilty of a felony and subject to a lifetime imprisonment and/or to a fine not less than \$500.00 and not exceeding \$5,000.00. Grooming is defined by the measure as the deliberate act of bringing a child into a sexual, political, or racial ideology, practice, cult, or lifestyle without the knowledge or consent of his or her parents for the aim of isolating the child from his or her family so the external party can abuse and manipulate him or her.
