**Bill Analysis**

SB 1331 directs the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to establish a Water and Wastewater Grant Program. The Program award competitive grants to counties and municipalities seeking to develop and implement water or wastewater improvement projects. The measure provides that applicant who provide matching funds to the proposed project shall receive a higher score in the grant award process. The measure provides for a clawback provision. The measure creates the Water and Wastewater Grant Program Revolving Fund, which shall consist of \$250 million apportioned sales tax revenue. Monies from the Fund shall be allocated in the following manner:

- 1) 25% for approved projects with a population of more than 400,000,
- 2) 25% for approved projects with a population of 30,000-400,000, and
- 3) 50% for approved projects with a population of less than 30,000
