## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1557 provides that evidence of prior domestic abuse or violence may be admissible during criminal case in which the defendant is accused of an offense involving domestic violence or abuse. The attorney for the state intending to offer such evidence shall disclose the evidence to the defendant 15 days before the commencement of trial or at such later time as the court may allow for good cause.
