Bill Analysis

SB 1681 prohibits any public employee from striking or engaging in an organized work stoppage against the state, a political subdivision of this state, or any public school district. Any employee who engages in such activities shall forfeit his or her employment, all civil service rights, pensions, reemployment rights, and any other rights, benefits, and privileges the employee enjoys as a result of public employment or former public employment. A teacher who engages in such activities shall have his or her teacher certificate revoked.
