Bill Analysis

SB 1702 modifies confidentiality as it relates to persons and entities that supply drugs for use in an execution by the state. The measure provides that confidentiality and exemption from discovery shall include any documents, records, photographs, or other information that may identify or reasonably lead directly or indirectly to the identification of any person or entity who participates in or administers the execution process or any person or entity who produces or supplies the drugs, medical supplies, or medical equipment for the execution. The measure also extends such confidentiality to producers of drugs used in state executions.
