Bill Analysis

SB 1742 requires any health benefit plan that offers coverage for contraceptives to provide coverage for a 3-month supply of a contraceptive drug the first time the enrollee obtains the drug and a 12-month supply of the drug each subsequent time that the enrollee obtains the same drug. An enrollee may obtain only one 12-month supply of a covered prescription drug during each 12-month period. The measure clarifies that enrollees may request a smaller supply or receive a smaller prescription from a provider if such a prescription is supported by clinical utility and medical appropriateness. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to any medication that could be used to terminate an existing pregnancy.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1742 accepts all House Amendments as well as restores the title and enacting clause. HA's add language excluding any contraceptive that could be used to terminate an existing pregnancy.

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
