Bill Analysis

SB 1835 authorizes the district attorney of a jurisdiction in which a person was convicted of an offense to file a motion in the district court to vacate or set aside a judgment of conviction at any time if clear and convincing evidence exists establishing that the defendant was convicted of an offense that the defendant did not commit. The measure provides that if the case was previously adjudicated by the Court of Criminal Appeals at any stage, then the appeal shall be filed with the Supreme Court.
