**Bill Analysis**

SB 239 authorizes municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties to enter into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure events. Agreements or memoranda made shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the federal schedule rate for equipment usage.
