Bill Analysis

SB 266 authorizes precinct officials to serve in more than 1 precinct with the written permission of the Secretary of the State Election Board. Such precincts must share the same election day polling place and have a combined total of no more than 7,500 voters. The secretary of the county election board must submit a request in writing to the Secretary of the State Election Board and separate election materials must be provided for each precinct so that a separate certification shall be made of the election results of each precinct. The measure also increases the maximum number of voters from 500 to 750 as it relates to designating a subprecinct.
