Bill Analysis

SB 473 establishes a judicial office in judicial District 7 and 14 respectively in order to establish a business court. The measure creates a Task Force for the Study of Business Courts. The task force shall be comprised of 11 members. The measure directs the task force to conduct an organizational meeting no later than September 30, 2024. The measure directs the task force to consider the establishment of a business court system in the state and to consider the existing court structure, court structures in other states, and other matters deemed relevant by the task force. Staff assistance shall be provided by the Secretary of State. The task force shall produce a report and submit it to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor no later than January 1, 2026. Nonlegislative members of the task force shall be reimbursed for travel expenses.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 473 completely replaces engrossed language with the language described above.
