**Bill Analysis**

SB 660 includes marijuana, cannabis, tetrahydrocannabinol, or its psychoactive components such as delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol, 11-hydroxy-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol in provisions relating to driving under the influence. Persons convicted of driving under the influence of marijuana shall be subject to the same punishments provided for driving under the influence of alcohol. The measure provides that Service Oklahoma, not the Department of Public Safety, shall revoke the license of a person convicted of certain crimes.
