Bill Analysis

SB 724 clarifies that the rights-of-way acquired by the county, in addition to the Department of Transportation as provided in current law, shall also be held inviolate for county purposes. The measure provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to construct, maintain or operate any gasoline pump, driveway canopy, building, sign, fence, post, or any thing or structure on or overhanging any right-of-way, or upon or overhanging any street occupied by a designated county road.
