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Bill Analysis

SB 783 directs the State Department of Health to regulate intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities with 16 or fewer beds (ICFs/IID-16) as distinct facilities separate from the provisions of the Nursing Home Care Act. Such regulations shall include licensure, licensure fees, staffing, quality of resident care, minimum standards for facilities, inspections, penalties, and violations.

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
