**Bill Analysis**

SB 809 modifies the term “cocktail” or “mixed drink” as it relates to the Oklahoma Cocktails To Go Act to clarify that such drinks shall not be limited to the examples provided by current law. The measure authorizes mixed beverage and mixed beverage/caterer combination licensees to provide curbside pickup and delivery. Customers are authorized to carry a sealed container from the licensed premises after purchasing a cocktail after being informed by the licensee that such a container shall be stored out of reach of the driver’s compartment.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 809 restores the title.
