Bill Analysis

SB 876 prohibits any nonresident from purchasing a hunting guide license unless the nonresident possesses and can exhibit a certificate of competency and safety in the use and handling of firearms from the Department of Wildlife Conservation. The measure also lowers the age from 30 to 21 as it relates to requiring persons to exhibit a certificate of competency prior to purchasing a hunting license. Nonresidents are prohibited from aiding persons in the taking of game for compensation or other consideration in the state without first obtaining a hunting guide license. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age, have a driving license, and possess a certificate of competency. The measure establishes a maximum fee of \$2,000.00 for violations of the provisions of this measure and provides for the revocation of a hunting guide license.
