**Bill Analysis**

SJR 34 submits to a vote of the people a section of the Oklahoma Constitution creating the Judicial Nominating Commission. Instead, the Governor shall appoint new appellate justices and judges, subject to confirmation of the Senate. If the Senate is not in session when the nomination was made, the Governor is authorized to call a special session for the Senate to consider the nomination. Appellate justices and judges appointed or retained after November 5, 2024, will serve during good behavior.
