Fiscal Analysis

SB 1470 creates the Oklahoma Survivors' Act. The measure provides that during a hearing to determine the sentence of a person or accept a plea of guilty for a person who survived domestic abuse, the court shall consider the physical, sexual, and psychological abuse a person experienced as mitigating factors. Defendants shall be required to provide documentary evidence corroborating that the defendant was, at the time of the offense or within 1 year of the offense, a victim of domestic abuse. The Department of Corrections does not anticipate a fiscal impact.
