Fiscal Analysis

SB 292 will require a standard serological test for syphilis at set times throughout a pregnancy. These times will require an additional two tests than is in current practice. OMES estimates an additional cost of between \$750,000-\$1 million for state employees and dependents thorough EGID. OHCA estimates a total cost of \$504,096 with a state share of \$163,882 for Medicaid recipients.
