6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;
8 allowing owners and operators of a licensed cervidae
9 facility to receive reimbursement under certain
10 conditions; prohibiting certain facilities from
receiving reimbursement; providing for promulgation
of rules; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-517 of Title 2, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. An owner or operator of a licensed farmed cervidae facility
18 may receive reimbursement from the Oklahoma Department of
19 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for disposals required by Section 6-
20 503 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such reimbursement shall
21 not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the value of the cervidae
22 disposed by the order.

23 B. An order for disposal by a licensed farmed cervidae facility
24 under the provisions of Section 6-515 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma

1 Statutes shall not be eligible for the reimbursement provided in
2 this section.

3 C. The Department shall promulgate the rules necessary for
4 assessing the value of the disposed cervidae and disbursement of
5 reimbursement to the licensed farmed cervidae facility.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
