SENATE BILL 216

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to long-term care; creating the Agency for Generational Excellence of Oklahomans (AGEOk); stating powers and duties; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1900 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Agency for Generational Excellence of Oklahomans (AGEOk).

B. AGEOk shall have the following powers and duties:

1. To oversee the development and implementation of rules and regulations of any agency, organization, or business responsible for the health and wellbeing of aging or vulnerable adults;

2. To ensure proper accountability and oversight of caregivers and facilities providing care;

3. To direct the education, training, and licensure of individuals responsible for the management of the care of aging or vulnerable adults; and

4. To advocate for the aging and vulnerable population through research, policy development, and agency accountability.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
