The proposed committee substitute for HB1005X offers any tribe with an existing motor vehicle licensing or registration agreement with state the option to affirm and extend the term of the agreement until December 31, 2024. A tribe may accept the supplemental terms by delivering a letter to the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The letter will then be filed with the Secretary of State.

This measure allows for the extension of tribal impacts on Motor Vehicle Licensing and Registration.
