### **Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute for SB 621 creates the Oklahoma Workforce Commission to coordinate the development of the workforce needed to grow Oklahoma's economy and Oklahomans' prosperity. The Commission will consist of nine members appointed by the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House. The Commission will administer the Workforce Development Revolving Fund, cooperate with public and private entities as needed, and enter into contracts or agreements for studies, professional services, grant administration and procurement, research projects, supplies, data collection, or any other services deemed necessary.
