6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; enacting the  
8 State Energy Freedom Act; providing that the  
9 development, production, distribution and sale of any  
10 energy products shall be determined by the State  
11 Legislature; reserving the exclusive right to enter  
12 into an energy compact; prohibiting restrictions by  
the federal government or agencies; providing for  
codification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1400 of Title 74, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "State  
18 Energy Freedom Act".

19 B. The development, production, distribution, and sale of any  
20 energy products shall be solely determined by the Oklahoma State  
21 Legislature. No state or federal agency or body shall interfere  
22 with these actions.

23 C. The State of Oklahoma reserves the exclusive right to enter  
24 into energy compact with any other state and shall not be subject to

1 restrictions imposed by the federal government or any federal  
2 agency.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
