L 4	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

21	B. Employees eligible for the increase provided for in
22	subsection A of this section who are on leave without pay on July 1,
23	2023, shall receive an annualized increase, effective upon their

return to work, but shall not receive any increase for a period of time prior to their return to work.

- C. Employees who leave the state service before July 1, 2023, and who are reinstated or reemployed in the state service during July 2023 without a break in service, who are otherwise eligible for the pay increase provided for in this section, shall be granted such raise effective immediately upon such reinstatement or reemployment. As used in this subsection, "break in service" is defined as a period of time in excess of thirty (30) calendar days between two periods of state employment.
- D. No salary increase pursuant to this section shall be made that exceeds a salary limitation provided in an agency's annual appropriation bill or salary limits set by statute.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
