12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.3b of Title 36, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. As used in this section:
16	1. "Contraceptive drugs" means all drugs approved by the United
17	States Food and Drug Administration that are used to prevent
18	pregnancy, including, but not limited to, hormonal drugs
19	administered orally, transdermally, and intravaginally; and
20	2. "Health benefit plan" means a health benefit plan as defined
21	pursuant to Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
22	B. 1. Any health benefit plan that is offered, issued, or
23	renewed on and after the effective date of this act that offers
24	coverage for contraceptive drugs shall provide reimbursement for a

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twelve-month prescription of contraceptive drugs obtained at one time by the enrollee. 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an enrollee of a health benefit plan from requesting a smaller supply or to prohibit a prescribing provider from prescribing a smaller supply if such a prescription is supported by clinical utility and medical appropriateness.
