15	A. There is hereby created the Agency for Generational
16	Excellence of Oklahomans (AGEOk).
17	B. AGEOk shall have the following powers and duties:
18	1. To oversee the development and implementation of rules and
19	regulations of any agency, organization, or business responsible for
20	the health and wellbeing of aging or vulnerable adults;
21	2. To ensure proper accountability and oversight of caregivers
22	and facilities providing care;

2	individuals responsible for the management of the care of aging or
3	vulnerable adults; and
4	4. To advocate for the aging and vulnerable population through
5	research, policy development, and agency accountability.
