PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to career and technology education; creating the Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech Assistance Act; providing short title; defining terms; creating the Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech Assistance Program to provide tuition assistance to certain eligible members; providing for amount of assistance subject to availability of funding; limiting assistance to certain number of years; allowing establishment of certain cap; prohibiting assistance for courses taken in excess of certain requirements; providing for eligibility; providing eligibility retention requirements; providing application process; allowing denial of continued assistance for failure to meet certain requirements; requiring repayment of assistance for failure to meet certain requirement; providing for calculation of repayment amount; allowing for application of hardship waiver; directing certain notification on available funding; providing for promulgation of rules and regulations; directing coordination of rules and regulations; creating the Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech Assistance Revolving Fund; specifying source of fund; providing for expenditures; providing purpose of fund; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-140 of Title 70, unless there
4 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
6 National Guard CareerTech Assistance Act".

7 B. As used in this act:

8 1. "Eligible Guard member" means a current member of the
9 Oklahoma National Guard in good standing who has a high school
10 diploma or who has completed General Educational Development (GED)
11 requirements and who has enrolled in a technology center school;

12 2. "Program" means the Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech
13 Assistance Program established pursuant to the provisions of this
14 act; and

15 3. "Technology center school" means a technology center school
16 district under the governance of the State Board of Career and
17 Technology Education.

18 C. 1. There is hereby created the Oklahoma National Guard
19 CareerTech Assistance Program to provide assistance to eligible
20 Guard members who enroll in a technology center school. Subject to
21 the availability of funds, the amount of assistance shall be
22 equivalent to the amount of tuition for a career and technology
23 program in which the eligible Guard member is enrolled leading to
24

1 certification or licensure, not to exceed a maximum of three (3)
2 years.

3 2. Assistance provided pursuant to this section shall be
4 granted, without any limitation other than the amount of funds
5 available for the program and the number of eligible Guard members
6 who apply, subject to any cap established by the Military Department
7 of the State of Oklahoma.

8 3. Assistance provided pursuant to this section shall not be
9 allowed for courses taken in excess of the requirements for
10 completion of a technology center school program leading to
11 certification or licensure.

12 D. Assistance provided pursuant to this section shall be
13 allocated to the technology center school from the Oklahoma National
14 Guard CareerTech Assistance Revolving Fund created pursuant to
15 Section 2 of this act.

16 E. To be eligible to apply for the program, an eligible Guard
17 member shall:

18 1. Have at least one (1) year remaining on his or her
19 enlistment contract at the beginning of any semester for which the
20 member applies for assistance pursuant to this section;

21 2. Agree in writing to complete his or her current service
22 obligation in the Oklahoma National Guard; and

23 3. Agree in writing to serve actively in good standing with the
24 Oklahoma National Guard for not less than twenty-four (24) months

1 after completion of the last semester for which the member receives
2 assistance pursuant to this act.

3 F. To retain eligibility for the program, an eligible Guard
4 member shall:

5 1. Maintain good academic standing and satisfactory progress
6 according to standards of the technology center school in which the
7 member is enrolled;

8 2. Maintain the requirements for retention and completion as
9 established by the technology center school in which the member is
10 enrolled;

11 3. Maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0
12 scale;

13 4. Maintain satisfactory participation in the Oklahoma National
14 Guard; and

15 5. Possess a Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) or Air Force
16 Specialty Code (AFSC) after his or her first semester.

17 G. An eligible Guard member seeking assistance pursuant to the
18 provisions of this act shall submit an application on a form
19 prescribed by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma to
20 the Educational Service Office of the Military Department prior to
21 the semester for which assistance is sought. The eligible Guard
22 member's Commander or his or her designee shall confirm a member's
23 standing and eligibility to the technology center school in which
24 the student is enrolled. The Military Department may establish a

1 cap on the number of eligible Guard members allowed to participate
2 per semester per technology center school program.

3 H. The eligible Guard member's Commander may deny an
4 application submitted by an eligible Guard member for continued
5 program assistance if he or she fails to comply with the provisions
6 of paragraph 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 of subsection F of this section.

7 I. An eligible Guard member who has received program assistance
8 pursuant to the provisions of this act and who fails to comply with
9 the provisions of paragraph 4 of subsection F of this section shall
10 be required to repay an amount to be calculated as follows:

11 1. Determine the total amount of assistance provided pursuant
12 to the provisions of this act;

13 2. Divide the amount determined in paragraph 1 of this
14 subsection by twenty-four (24); and

15 3. Multiply the amount determined in paragraph 2 of this
16 subsection by the number of months the member did not fulfill the
17 requirements of paragraph 4 of subsection F of this section.

18 Repayments shall be deposited into the Oklahoma National Guard
19 CareerTech Assistance Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 2
20 of this act.

21 J. An eligible Guard member who has received program assistance
22 pursuant to the provisions of this act and who fails to comply with
23 the provisions of paragraph 4 of subsection F of this section due to
24 hardship circumstances may request a waiver from repayment. A

1 waiver request shall be submitted in writing to the Adjutant
2 General.

3 K. By July 1 annually, the State Board of Career and Technology
4 Education shall notify the Adjutant General of the amount of funding
5 available in the Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech Assistance
6 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 2 of this act.

7 L. The State Board of Career and Technology Education shall
8 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act including
9 deadlines for submission of applications required by subsection G of
10 this section. The Military Department of the State of Oklahoma
11 shall promulgate regulations pertaining to the application process
12 and the determination of eligibility for the program. The Board and
13 the Department shall coordinate the promulgation of rules and
14 regulations, respectively. The Adjutant General may promulgate
15 regulations to implement the provisions of this act.

16 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-141 of Title 70, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
20 for the State Board of Career and Technology Education to be
21 designated the "Oklahoma National Guard CareerTech Assistance
22 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
23 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
24 by the State Board of Career and Technology Education from state

1 appropriations provided for the purpose of implementing the
2 provisions of Section 1 of this act. All monies accruing to the
3 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
4 expended by the State Board of Career and Technology Education for
5 the purpose of providing assistance to eligible Guard members
6 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act. Expenditures
7 from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
8 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
9 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
10 approval and payment.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

12 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
