- 1. Submitting a renewal application to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry on the form prescribed by the Department;
 - 2. Complying with any other renewal requirements adopted by the Department; and
 - 3. Paying the required fee.
 - B. Any person who fails to apply for a renewal in a manner prescribed by the Department, and whose license has expired, may not engage in activities that require a license until the license has been renewed.
 - C. Not later than sixty (60) ninety (90) days before the expiration of the license, the Department shall send written notice of the impending license expiration to the animal shelter operator or commercial pet breeder at the last-known address according to the records of the Department.
 - D. The Department shall provide an online license renewal and payment option by January 1, 2026.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
