AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2021, Section 896.5, is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 Section 896.5. The Oklahoma Legislature finds that certain 16 free-flowing streams and rivers of Oklahoma possess such unique 17 natural scenic beauty, water, fish, wildlife, and outdoor 18 recreational values of present and future benefit to the people of 19 the state that it is the policy of the Legislature to preserve these 20 areas for the benefit of the people of Oklahoma. For this purpose, 21 the following are hereby designated as scenic rivers: 22 The Flint Creek in Delaware County; 23 2. The Illinois River in Adair, Delaware and Cherokee Counties 24 above its confluence with the Barren Fork Creek;

1 The Barren Fork Creek in Adair and Cherokee Counties from 2 the present alignment of U.S. Highway 59 West west to its confluence 3 with the Illinois River; 4 4. The Upper Mountain Fork River above the 600-foot six-5 hundred-foot elevation level of Broken Bow Reservoir in McCurtain 6 and LeFlore Le Flore Counties; 7 5. Big Lee Creek in Sequoyah County, above the 420-foot four-8 hundred-twenty-foot MSL elevation; and 9 6. Little Lee Creek in Adair and Sequoyah Counties; 10 The Glover River in McCurtain County; and 7. 11 8. The Kiamichi River in Le Flore, Choctaw, and Pushmataha 12 Counties. 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. 14 SECTION 3.
