Supp. 2024, 17 Section 199.10), is amended to read as follows: 18 Section 199.10. A. All licenses issued under the provisions of 19 the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be issued for a 20 period of one (1) year. The expiration date of the license shall be 21 the last day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls. 22 The public display of a licensee's personal residential address on 23

the face of any license issued pursuant to the provisions of the

Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be prohibited on and

after July 1, 2016, and such personal address information, if publicly displayed on a valid license, may be redacted by the licensee until the license is renewed and no longer bears his or her personal residential address.

- B. 1. Beginning January 1, 2026, as a condition of renewal or reactivation of the license, each licensee shall submit to the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering evidence of completion of twelve (12) hours of continuing education courses approved by the Board, within the twenty-four (24) months immediately preceding the term for which the license is to be issued.
- 2. The Board shall promulgate rules for subjects to be included in the continuing education. Each licensee shall be required to complete and include as part of the requirements of the continuing education a specified number of required subjects as prescribed by rule.
- C. Applications for renewal must be made on or before the last day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls, and shall be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
- C. D. Any person who fails to renew the license within the required time may make application for renewal at any time within five (5) years from the expiration date of the license by paying the regular renewal license fee and a late fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), which becomes due two (2) months after the expiration date.
