18	female patient unless:
19	1. That patient gave informed written consent to the pelvic
20	examination;
21	2. The performance of the pelvic examination is within the
22	scope of care for a surgical procedure or diagnostic examination; or
23	beepe of eare for a surgicul procedure of aragnostic examination, or
