- 3. "Political Subdivision" means a city, incorporated town, or county within this state.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1253 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Notwithstanding any other statutory requirement or agency rule, a political subdivision shall not impose minimum parking mandates for residential, commercial, or industrial properties within its jurisdiction.
- B. This act does not prohibit a political subdivision from passing an ordinance or enforcing laws related to disability parking spaces.
- SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
