18	A. Any person who is apprehended and arrested for violating a

20	status of the person is found to be unlawfully present in the United
21	States, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in
22	the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to

exceed life.

- B. In lieu of the sentence of imprisonment, the court shall have the authority to suspend the criminal prosecution and issue a written order discharging the person and requiring said individual to return to his or her country of origin. Upon issuance of the written order, the court shall direct the law enforcement agency having custody of the person to remand the person to the custody of the Department of Corrections with instructions to return the person to his or her country of origin.
- C. Once the Department receives custody of the person, the
 Department shall notify the United States Customs and Border
 Protection of the Department of Homeland Security to arrange
 transportation for the repatriation of said person back to his or
 her country of origin.
- D. Should the person return to the State of Oklahoma after repatriation and be apprehended by law enforcement, the person shall be subject to revocation of the suspended sentence and ordered by the court to serve the entirety of his or her original sentence of imprisonment.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
