HB 1832, as introduced, adds a definition of *intermediate care facility* which means an institution that is primarily for the diagnosis, treatment, or rehabilitation of the intellectually disabled or people with related conditions. The measure adds intermediate care facilities to statutes addressing electronic monitoring devices.

HB 1832 adds "intermediate care facilities" to certain sections of the Oklahoma Statutes regarding electronic monitoring in long-term care facilities.
