**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2256 in its current form, creates the Apprentice Scholarship Program Revolving and grant program, within the Oklahoma State Board of Career and Technology Education. The Program establishes a framework to support financial resources for tuition and fees of eligible high school graduates enrolling in federally approved apprenticeship programs in technical trades.

The measure as drafted creates a program and Revolving Fund but contains no funding. Funding amounts, would be directed in future legislation in amounts as determined appropriate by the Legislature. For these reasons HB 2256 in its current form has no direct impact on the State Budget or Revenues.
