HB 2734 clarifies that inquiries by a person being stopped, detained, or arrested by a law enforcement officer or by a bystander who is observing another person being stopped, detained, or arrested by a law enforcement officer, is not considered obstruction of justice, unless such inquiries by the person or bystander are purposefully intended to hinder, delay, or obstruct.
