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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1058 requires any health care provider visiting a mother or infant during the perinatal period to conduct a mental health screening of the mother to check for signs of perinatal depression and anxiety. The measure directs the State Department of Health to develop a website that shall be available to the public showing information on programs, services, and other resources for women and infants during the perinatal period. The measure authorizes the Department to conduct a survey of maternal health, mental health, and infant health using the website. Data gathered by the survey shall be published an annual report on the Department's website and provided to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor.

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
