Bill Analysis

SB 255 creates an income tax credit equal to 70% of the cost of qualified expenses used to control and manage feral swine populations, minimize agricultural damage caused by feral swine, or mitigate ecological impacts caused by feral swine. Natural persons or business entities claiming the credit must own at least 20 acres. Individual awards for the credit are capped at \$15,000.00 and may be carried forward for a period of 5 years.
