**Bill Analysis**

SB 275 creates the Oklahoma Workforce Housing Commission and sets the sunset date for the Commission on December 30, 2034. The Commission shall be comprised of 5 members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor respectively as well as 3 ex officio members. Members shall not receive a salary, but may be reimbursed for travel. The meetings of the Commission shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The Commission shall promulgate rules relating to developing an initial assessment of workers' housing needs, a comprehensive Oklahoma affordable housing annual report, long-term expansion of workforce and affordable housing, updating implementation and outcomes of the investment in the Oklahoma Housing Stability Program, and making recommendations to the Legislature. The measure also creates the Oklahoma Workforce Housing Commission Revolving Fund.
