**Bill Analysis**

SB 28 directs school districts during the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 school years to provide meals at no cost to students who are members of a household with a total annual income during the preceding tax year of less than 250% of the federal poverty level. It directs funds to be apportioned by the State Board of Education for this purpose.
