Bill Analysis

SB 454 modifies the grading scale for the A-F rating system. The measure removes F and defines an A as a school making above average progress, a B as a school making satisfactory progress, and a C as a school that needs support. The bill removes the authority for the State Board of Education to adopt an alternate accountability system for statewide virtual charter schools. The measure also removes “school climate” as a metric for grading a school and instead provides that schools shall be evaluated on school-based social support services.
