Bill Analysis

SB 481 prohibits any public employee from striking or engaging in an organized work stoppage against the state, public school district, or political subdivision. Any employee violating this provision shall automatically forfeit his or her employment as well as all civil service rights, pensions, reemployment rights, and any other rights, benefits, and privileges the employee enjoys as a result of public employment or former public employment. Teachers who violate this provision shall have their teaching certificate revoked.
